



Performing Arts Program '26

The students are encouraged to actively participate in Music, Dance, Drama and Media Studies.

Program Outline Term 2

Foundation – Music / Drama

An introduction to new action songs related to classroom themes.
DRAMA – based on the book 'Magic Beach'.
Students explore role-play and dramatic action from the story using imagination, pictures/videos and props (spades, blue material and surfboards).
Students will focus on developing and expanding music and drama vocabulary linked to the unit.

Grade 1 – Music / Drama

Students explore pitch and melody through singing and instrumental work.
Games played promoting students listening with active responses.
DRAMA focused on building confidence and relationships.
Students use their imagination to role-play ideas in different settings e.g. home, park, beach etc.
Students will focus on developing and expanding music and drama vocabulary linked to the unit.

Grade 2 – Music

An introduction to action songs incorporating body percussion and instruments. Focus on key musical elements - rhythm, melody, and form—through engaging listening games. Further exploration of orchestral instruments and their unique musical tones.
Students will focus on developing and expanding music vocabulary linked to the unit.

Grades 3/4/5 Concert – Musical Theatre

An introduction to class concert items connected to the theme of the show. Regular rehearsals will be held, with ongoing preparation leading up to the final performances.
Students will focus on developing and expanding Performing Arts vocabulary linked to the unit.

Grade 6 - Media

Using media technology, the students will create digital advertising promoting Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander literature. Media art works will include script writing and storyboarding captured with digital devices. Students will focus on developing and expanding their Media vocabulary linked to the unit.
