HOMEWORK

Year 3 students will be asked to read at least 20 minutes a day at home to a family member if possible. The students are their reading diaries. Please sign your child's take home diary First Fleet. They will practise thinking and acting like each day they have read and record date, title and a comment if you like. Make sure their take home diary is placed back into their reading satchels for the teacher to check every Friday.

Curriculum Overview



READING

In Reading this term, students are beginning to establish reading routines in the classroom. They are focusing on making various connections in order to better understand what they read. We will also be asking clarifying questions about parts of texts or unknown words. Finally, they will focus on the strategy of 'inferring' to assist with their understanding of characters' feelings and traits throughout books they read.



WRITING

In Writing this term, the Grade 3 students will be focusing on Narrative and Persuasive texts. We will be looking at the structure and features that these genres have.

We will also have a focus on making our writing interesting by including elements such as adjectives, dialogue and sizzling starts. Students will also be exploring how to include paragraphs in their writing as well as how to use correct punctuation.



MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics this term, students will be measuring, ordering and comparing objects using familiar metric units of length. Our students will also identify the place value of numbers up to and beyond 10,000. They will also build problem solving strategies to solve addition and subtraction problems and understand the relationship they have with each other.



In Inquiry this term, the grade 3 students will learn about the lives of the First Australians before European settlers arrived asked to read 5 times a week and record their daily reading in In Australia and the causes and reasons for the journey of the historians as they are immersed in stories of first contact between Indigenous Australians and European Settlers.
