Prep – Inquiry unit: Fairness and Friendship

Focus: Ordering events, character's speaking and repeating words in stories.

Year One and Two – Inquiry unit: Celebrating Differences

Focus: Vocabulary and character's behaviours in a story.

Year Three and Four- Inquiry unit: Someone Else's Shoes

Focus: Author's message, facts in stories and events.

Year Five and Six – Inquiry unit: Care for Kids

Focus: Research facts, subject specific vocabulary and higher order thinking.
