CURRICULUM

The children will continue tasks and assessments in English and Mathematics. They will be working on activities that are specifically tailored to their needs.

In Writing, students will focus on narrative writing and continue working on punctuation and editing and expanding their sentences.

Students will continue to be exposed to reading in a variety of formats including media, film, digital and traditional forms that will enhance their comprehension skills.

The students will be engaging in a spelling program focused on building their morphological knowledge.

We encourage the students to continually practise their times tables to help them solve problems more efficiently.

In Humanities this Term, students will be exploring social justice. Students will learn about some of the biggest problems facing children around the world and the aid agencies working to help solve these problems. They will practise making values-based decisions in response to ethical dilemmas.
