## CURRICULUM INFORMATION



### English

This term, students will continue to engage in the Little Learners Loves Literacy (LLLL) program and the Heggerty program.

We will focus on:

- Phonemic awareness: knowing that each letter of the alphabet makes a sound and hearing them in words.
- Decoding words
- Handwriting
- Rhyming words
- Vocabulary
- Sentence structures



### Humanities

Sustainability: Where We Live

Students will be immersed into sustainability by thinking about how to care for and sustain different places.



### Writing

Students will continue to practise writing the correct letter to match the taught sounds. They will learn to identify uppercase and lowercase letters and understand their purpose within sentences. Students will also practise forming sentences.

We will focus on:

- Correct letter formation
- Letter – Sound relationships
- Writing simple sentences
- Word knowledge (what a word is and how words are formed)



### Reading

Students will identify some features of texts and practise reading behaviours, such as:

- Pointing to words and letters.
- Reading from left to right.
- Heart Words (LLLL)
- Identifying sentences
- Decodable texts (take home books)



### Maths

We will continue to engage in mathematical learning through the PRIME Mathematics Program.

We will focus on:

- Numbers from 10-20
- Sorting and Surveys
- Making and breaking numbers into 'wholes' and 'parts'.
