Curriculum

The children will continue tasks and assessments in English and Mathematics. They will be working on activities that are specifically tailored to their needs.

In Writing, students will focus on narrative writing and continue working on punctuation and editing and expanding their sentences.

Students will continue to be exposed to reading in a variety of formats including media, film, digital and traditional forms that will enhance their comprehension skills.

In Inquiry this Term, students will be immersed in social justice through our new unit 'Care for the kids' to learn about problems children are facing around the world and how they can make a difference for the future.

The students will continue with their spelling program with a weekly test.

We encourage the students to continually practise their times tables to help them solve problems more efficiently.
