CURRICULUM

LITERACY

In Literacy, students will focus on utilising reading strategies for their independent reading. They will engage in activities tailored to meet their individual needs.

In Writing, students will concentrate on narrative and persuasive writing, with students delving into the structure and characteristics of narrative texts. They will actively participate in a customised weekly spelling program and work on advancing their grammar skills.

NUMERACY

In Numeracy, students will be commencing with PRIME Mathematics program. Focus this term will be place value, approximation and estimation, factors and multiples, multiplication, division, order of operations and place value. Students will also be completing set tasks to prepare them for NAPLAN.

INQUIRY

For Inquiry, the focus is on Democracy. Students will be learning about the values needed within a community, rules that are designed to protect people's rights, and the responsibility they have on others.
