Curriculum

LITERACY

In Reading, the students will be working on Reading strategies which they will apply to their own independent reading.

They will be working on activities focusing on decoding, comprehension and fluency that are suited to their needs.

In Writing, there will be a focus on Early Harvest writing competition by 100 Story Building. Students will be developing their writing, including key features of a narrative text. Student will commence their development of their student-led conferences that will be presented in Term 3.

Students will continue their weekly spelling program suited to their needs that focus on spelling patterns and phonics as well as building their grammar skills.

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics, we will continue our Prime Mathematics Program focusing on key mathematical operations, measurement, data, grids, fractions, money and time.

INQUIRY

The Inquiry unit will consider sustainability and environmental factors in our world as the children learn about the values of contribution, collaboration and our impact on the earth. Students will learn a deeper understanding about what our role is in sustaining a balance within our environment.
