CURRICULUM

Students will continue to use the PRIME Mathematics program which encompasses the I do, we do, you do approach. It uses concrete, pictorial and abstract resources to encourage the students to become more independent.

In Literacy, students will use mentor texts to learn about influential people to assist them in writing leadership speeches. Students will continue to be exposed to reading in a variety of formats including media, film, digital and traditional forms that will enhance their comprehension skills. The students will continue with their spelling programme with a weekly test.

Students will have the opportunity to participate in a Leadership excursion and incursion to help them identify and develop their leadership qualities and skills.

In Humanities, students will learn about the key features of the electoral process and the different responsibilities of each level of government in Australia. They will consider the values of Australia's democracy and the important qualities of leaders.

We encourage the students to continually practise their times tables for homework every week.
