Curriculum

The children will continue tasks and assessments in English and Mathematics. They will be working on activities that are specifically tailored to their needs.

In Writing, students will focus on narrative writing and continue working on punctuation and editing.

Students will continue to be exposed to reading in a variety of formats including media, film, digital and traditional forms that will enhance their comprehension skills.

In Inquiry this Term, students will be immersed in science through our new unit 'The journey of Discovery'. They will learn about light refraction, electrical circuits, states of matter and the scale of the solar system through hands on experiments and experiences.

The students will continue with their spelling programme with a weekly test.

We encourage the students to continually practise their times tables to help them solve problems more efficiently.
