At St Albans Meadows Primary School, students have the opportunity to learn the Italian language and study the Italian culture. Our focus is on communicating and understanding how a language works and gaining insights into the culture which gives the language its life and meaning. Students learn to communicate in Italian for many purposes and in many contexts.

FOUNDATION

This term, students in Foundation will be focusing on developing their listening and speaking skills. We will be learning about where Italy is in the world and the Italian flag. We will also be learning basic greetings, basic classroom instructions and begin to learn to count in Italian.

YEARS 1 TO 6

This term, students from Years 1 to 6 will study aspects of Italian culture and language. They will learn about the 2026 Winter Olympics being held in Italy, in Milan-Cortina and explore Carnevale, Italy's vibrant traditional festival. In addition, students will develop their Italian language skills by learning how to greet others, introduce themselves, and answer simple questions about themselves
