Curriculum

Students will be introduced to the new PRIME Mathematics program which encompasses the I do, we do, you do approach. It uses concrete, pictorial and abstract resources to encourage the students to become more independent.

In Literacy , students use mentor texts to learn about influential people to assist them in writing leadership speeches. Students will continue to be exposed to reading in a variety of formats including media, film, digital and traditional forms that will enhance their comprehension skills. The students will continue with their spelling programme with a weekly test.

Student will have the opportunity to participate in numerous Leadership excursions and incursions to help them identify leadership qualities.

In Inquiry this Term, students will look at the different levels of government and making a democracy.
