Program Outline

- Foundation – Learning new action songs and rehearsing for an assembly performance.**
An introduction to the National Anthem – Advance Australia Fair

Listening and responding to a variety of music games.
DRAMA – based on the book ‘Magic Beach’.
Students role-play ideas from the story using imagination, images and props (spades, blue material and surfboards). In groups students create images and tell stories.
- Grade 2 –** Singing skills will be developed through a variety of listening games, instrumental work, movement activities and practising songs. Lessons will focus on pitch, rhythm and maintaining a steady tempo. Form in songs will be explored as well as singing in canon.
- Grade 3 -** Introduction to reading music notation and developing vocabulary such as: treble clef, stave, note names, bars, time signature etc.
Introduction to the recorder and note positions. Students learn simple melodies.

Regular rehearsals will be conducted and preparations will be made leading up to the performances.

- Grade 6** YABBA – short plays (Drama)
Students, in small groups, will construct short plays, including an original script, that illustrate a positive social learning and/or behaviour at SAMPS. For example, ‘Do the Right Bin’ to reinforce the idea of putting rubbish in the correct bin (landfill, recycling, compost).
