


Library Term 1 2026

All students at St. Albans Meadows Primary School have an one hour library class once a week. An instructional lesson is given for 40 minutes, where the main focus is on literature, based from the English Curriculum.

A further 20 minutes is provided for borrowing books to take home.



- Library classes are held weekly to develop regular borrowing and reading habits. When children borrow books they need to return their books each week on or before their library class.
- For library classes ALL children need to have a named library bag. This is important so we can encourage children to respect and look after books. Foundation children receive their library bag from the school. A material supermarket bag also makes an excellent library bag. Please ensure the child's name is written on the bag.
- Foundation children start to borrow towards the middle of term 1.

In library classes the children acquire different knowledge, skills and practices using a variety of learning strategies. Children are also encouraged to read for enjoyment and pleasure.

The library is open to students in grade 3 to 6 on Monday lunchtimes for 'Chess Club'.

Children also have opportunity to read in the library during lunchtimes on various days throughout the week.
