Prep, Year 1, Year 2 and Year 3 students will be diving into a vibrant “Food Art” unit, using inspiration from fruits, vegetables, and sweet treats. Our young artists will be “cooking up” a colourful storm by transforming recycled & repurposed materials into artworks that look good enough to eat! From oversized ice creams to imaginative veggie creations, students will explore how everyday materials can be reimagined into playful, eye-catching pieces.

Along the way, important art skills will be carefully woven into their learning. Students will build confidence in cutting, assembling, printmaking, painting, working with ink, and collage techniques. Each lesson is designed like a creative recipe, combining imagination, skill-building, and a touch of fun to produce truly spectacular, super-sized artworks. We can’t wait to share their creations with you!

Year 4, 5 and 6 students will be exploring a meaningful and creative unit titled “Expression and Sustainability,” where art connects closely with their Humanities learning about the environment and endangered animals. Students will investigate how artists use their work to express ideas and raise awareness about important global issues, while also reflecting on their own role in caring for the planet.

Students will experiment with a wide range of materials, including recycled items to design and construct imaginative 3D animals and insects. Through this process, they will explore how texture, form and structure can bring their creations to life. Year 4 students will draw inspiration from the artist Matisse, using bold colours and expressive shapes to create vibrant, eye-catching backgrounds that complement their sculptures.

Year 4, 5 and 6 students will build their understanding of the element of value, learning how to use shading and tonal techniques to add depth and realism to their artwork. This unit encourages both artistic skill development and thoughtful reflection, resulting in powerful pieces that combine creativity, sustainability and self-expression.
