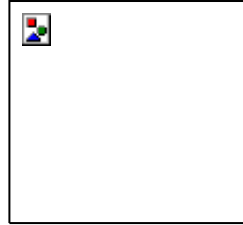


Library News – term 2



- Library classes are held weekly to develop regular borrowing and reading habits. **When children borrow books they need to return their books each week on or before their library class.**
- For library classes ALL children need to have a named library bag. This is important so we can encourage children to respect and look after books.
A material supermarket bag is also sufficient to use as a library bag.

In library classes the children will acquire different knowledge, skills and practices using a variety of learning strategies.

Children will be encouraged to read for enjoyment and pleasure.

Literature and literacy studies will also take place during library classes to complement and support the classroom English curriculum focusing on interpreting, analyzing and evaluating books.
